**(Virginia Beach, VA)** Virginia Beach citizens are invited to review plans for Providence Park, a 16-acre park site located at the intersection of Reon Drive and Providence Road, purchased through the City of Virginia Beach Open Space Acquisition program. Providence Park has been planned for an active recreation park to include multi-use playing fields, restrooms, trails, and parking. In addition, a portion of the site will be dedicated to relocation of existing ball fields currently used by the Kempsville Pony League. The site is planned for development starting in Spring 2007, and the park opening is planned for Spring 2008.
